



NO-SHOW POLICY

Any golfer missing an established starting time will receive the following:

First Offense

The player will be allowed to participate in the next event and is eligible for awards but is not eligible to earn Player Performance Ranking (PPR) points.

If the penalized event (the next tournament) is a national qualifying tournament the player is eligible to earn the national qualifying "spot" but he/she will not receive PPR Qualifying points for qualifying and will not be eligible for PPR Performance points for his/her play at the national tournament.

Second Offense

Disqualification and loss of entry fee from the next tournament that the player has entered to participate in and he/she will not be allowed to play in that event (exception for national qualifying tournament as previously indicated). Additionally, the player will be ineligible to participate on a Utah Team or in a UJGA Invitational event

Third Offense

Suspended membership and a written explanation given by the player to the Executive Committee who will determine the length of suspension.

NOTE: If a player withdraws from a tournament after the deadline period the player is still considered a NO-Show. The result of this action is the entry fee will not be refunded or credited to the players "credit account" (penalty is loss of the entry fee).

If a player withdraws after the first round of two-day tournament the action is considered a NO-Show, the penalty for this infraction of the policy is the player is disqualified and loss of entry fee for the next tournament that the player has entered to participate in. If the withdraw is due to injury the players action will be considered a "withdraw due to injury", no penalty action will be assessed, the player must provide proof of injury with a doctor's note.
