



DRESS CODE

Required Dress at the Golf Course

- Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward.
- Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks (host golf course permitting) must be tucked in at all times while at the golf facility.
- Women's fashion shirts without a collar must have sleeves.
- Women's fashion shirts must not rise above the belt line at any time during the golf swing.
- Women's skorts and skirts must be mid-thigh in length. Shorts must have a minimum inseam measurement of 6”.

Prohibited Dress at the Golf Course

- Tank tops, T-shirts
- Denim shorts, short-shorts, cut-off shorts, jeans, athletic wear (which includes gym shorts, compression shorts, sweatpants, yoga pants-unless worn under women’s skorts or skirt of proper length)
- Tattoos (must be covered)

Proper attire is required at all times at the host golf facility. Questionable attire will be reviewed by the Tournament Committee. Should a host golf course have a stricter dress code, its policy will take precedence. Players in violation of the dress code will not be allowed to tee off.

Penalty for Dress Code breach

A player who does not confirm to the dress code prior to the start of his / her stipulated round will not be allowed to play. A warning will be given to a player who began the round in compliance, but who later falls outside of the policy. If the player subsequently falls outside the policy and it is apparent that player is abusing the policy, **the player will be disqualified**. This action will also be taken if the player demonstrates a defiant attitude with respect to the rule. Disqualification for breach of the dress code can result in a player’s membership being suspended under the Code of Conduct policy.
