



## **CADDIES / MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS**

### **UJGA Jr. Tour**

#### **Boys 15-18 / 13-14 / 11-12 Divisions; Girls 15-18 / 13-14 Divisions**

Caddies or the use of a Motorized Golf Cart are NOT ALLOWED at UJGA sanctioned events except that caddies are allowed for the USGA U.S. Junior Amateur; U.S. Girls Junior qualifying tournaments and carts are allowed for the Challenge Cup and Border War Matches. (NOTE: If a caddie is employed at a USGA event they must meet the USGA's caddie requirements as indicated on the USGA tournament entry form).

#### **Boys 10 Under Division / Girls 11-12; 10 Under Divisions**

The UJGA has adopted the policy of **"REQUIRING"** Caddies for the Boys & Girls 10 & Under Divisions. In addition, the Girls 11-12 divisions **"MAY"** have a caddie if the player chooses. All Caddies must follow the UJGA Code of Conduct rules, this to include the UJGA Dress Code.

Caddie requirements:

- Must be at least 14 years of age and a family member (parent, guardian, sibling, grandparent, aunt, uncle, or cousin).
- Inappropriate conduct will result in the immediate revoking of a Caddies' privileges as defined in the Rules of Golf.
- A person may caddie for more than one player in a group, however both players must be related to the caddie (see relationship requirement above). In this situation the caddie must advise the other players / parents in the group that he will be assisting both players.
- Golf Cart are allowed, both player and caddie are allowed to ride in the cart. NOTE: The payment for the use of the golf cart is the responsibility of the Caddie or player.

**As provided in the Rules of the Golf and UJGA policies, the following are things that a caddie is NOT ALLOWED to do:**

- STAND on the TEEING AREA, this includes behind the player as an extension of the line of play while the player is taking their stance.
- WALK-ON or touch or test the surface of a putting green.
- Prevent a ball from traveling its original path or placement.
- Give advice to other players unless you are also caddying for them.
