



UJGA GALLERY POLICY

The UJGA allows galleries at all sanctioned events, if approved by the golf course. When a gallery is permitted, the UJGA has adopted a Code of Conduct for all galleries; the following is a summary of the gallery rules:

- **GALLERY PASS:** If a Gallery Pass is provided, all gallery members must wear the pass in a visible manner.
- **WALKING NEXT TO A PLAYER is prohibited.** Gallery members must maintain a **100-foot distance from all players**, keep up with the group they are following and remain on the cart path if one is provided (remain in the rough-cut area if no cart path).
- **WALKING IN THE FAIRWAY CUT of the hole being played is prohibited** with the exception that a gallery member may cross a fairway to aide in the search of a golf ball or to get to the next hole.
- **WALKING BEHIND THE GROUP is prohibited.**
- **GOLF CART rental is permitted by Gallery** members if allowed by the golf course staff.
- **COACHING or GIVING ADVICE to ANY PLAYER** during a stipulated round is prohibited.
- **CELL PHONE USE in “talking mode” while on the golf course is prohibited.** Gallery members are allowed to “text” messages and must keep the cell phone in a “vibrating” mode.
- **CARRYING A PERSONAL GOLF CLUB** while on the golf course is a prohibited act.

Gallery members may:

- Make positive comments on the player’s performance as long as no prejudice is shown toward a specific player.

Gallery Members are responsible for knowing and abiding by the UJGA “Gallery Rules” while on the golf course. Failure to comply with the UJGA Gallery Policy may result in a player being disqualified and/or the Gallery Members’ privileges being revoked.

PENALTY: If a parent or gallery member is offering advice to a player, it is assumed that the player is accepting the advice. The player will be penalized with the general penalty (2-strokes) for breach of Rule 10; the gallery member will lose their gallery privileges and will be asked to leave the golf course.
