



## PLAYER PERFORMANCE RANKING POINTS SCHEDULE

Player Performance Points are awarded for a player's finish in sanctioned UJGA tournaments, both Stroke and Match Play. *(See bottom of page for the definition of "sanctioned" tournaments).* UJGA tournaments include the following:

### STROKE PLAY SCHEDULES

- 18-hole
- 36-hole
- 54-hole
- 54-hole with a CUT (Cuts are for 20, 8, 6, 3 and ties)
- State and National QUALIFYING tournaments (includes Allied Associations)
- State and National CHAMPIONSHIP tournaments (includes Allied Associations)

### MATCH PLAY SCHEDULE

- MATCH PLAY / 64 Qualifying
- MATCH PLAY / 32 Qualifying
- MATCH PLAY / 16 Qualifying
- MATCH PLAY / 8 Qualifying
- MATCH PLAY / 4 Qualifying

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### SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

For a tournament to be a UJGA sanctioned tournament, it must be 1) Run by the UJGA Staff, or 2) Run by an approved allied association of the UJGA or a National Championship that the UJGA conducts a qualifying tournament for. PPR points will not be awarded at non-sanctioned tournaments at the local or national level.

Qualifying players are eligible to participate in the QUALIFYING points, BONUS points and PERFORMANCE points based on their finish at the national event using the appropriate Schedule.

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### QUALIFYING POINTS

UJGA Members who qualify for National and State tournaments through UJGA sanctioned tournaments will receive **100-Qualifying Points** **IF THE QUALIFIER PARTICIPATES** in the National or State tournament that they have qualified for. NOTE: An Alternate player is not considered a QUALIFIER. The Alternate is eligible for PERFORMANCE and BONUS points but is not eligible for QUALIFYING points.

**200-Qualifying Points** are also awarded for USGA National tournaments and UTAH TEAM members for the Border War, Junior Americas Cup, Girls Junior Americas Cup, Eddie Hogan Cup, UJGA Challenge Cup and Woodland Cup teams. NOTE: Qualifying points are awarded at the conclusion of the national tournament.

IMPORTANT: Players who obtain exempt status in National and State tournaments based on the previous year's play AND who originally qualified for the National or State tournament through a UJGA sanctioned tournament will receive **100-Qualifying Points**, if they play in the Championship.

In addition, ALL UJGA members who participate in the "Local Qualifying" Tournament for any USGA Championship will receive **50 Qualifying Points for playing in the qualifying event**; this is in addition to any PERFORMANCE points that may be awarded based on their play. NOTE: If Utah does not provide a "Local Qualifying" tournament, a player may earn points if they played in a sanctioned qualifying tournament in another state. The PPR schedule used is the 36H for an 18-hole qualifying tournament.

NOTE: Qualifying points are awarded due to the player having to meet a handicap requirement to play in the event.

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### PERFORMANCE POINTS

A player may earn PERFORMANCE POINTS based on their finish at National and State tournaments if they qualified for the National or State tournament through a UJGA sanctioned tournament. The National / State Championship PPR schedule is used.

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### BONUS POINTS

(Make Cut / Qualify for Match Play)

If a player **MAKES THE CUT or QUALIFIES FOR MATCH PLAY** at a Utah State or National Championship, the player will be awarded 50 BONUS Points (in addition to points awarded per the PPR schedule). BONUS points are only awarded for divisions that have a Cut for Stroke Play; all Match Play events are eligible.

**NOTE: Player Performance Rankings are used to determine Utah Teams, Golfer of the Year, "All – Jr. Team" selection, and invitations to TUCKER Tour Championship and the SWIRE Cup.**
